Setup Instructions

Congratulations, your new Quadjoy Mouse will change your computing life as you know it! It might not open doors, but it will open *many* Windows...ENJOY!

Hardware Setup:

First: After unpacking your mouse and the flexible arm, thread the flexible arm into the brass fitting in the right side of the Quadjoy Mouse body. This may be difficult at first as both the Quadjoy and Mouse Arm are new and have not been worn in. Be careful to thread the mouse in only three to four turns or until it starts to get hard to turn, whichever comes first. Then, turn the quadjoy mouse back ¼ turn and rotate the brass knurled nut counterclockwise until it is hand tight up against the Quadjoy Mouse. Then turn the mouse only, forward ¼ of a turn. The brass knurled nut will turn with the Quadjoy Mouse, but after about ¼ turn it should be hard to move the Quadjoy Mouse.

Second: Unpack your clamp and pull the plastic cap off of the mounting stud that you wish to use. Take the flexible mounting arm which you just attached to the Quadjoy and pull back the knurling ring (round rough textured brass piece at the end of the arm) (be sure that there are no packing peanuts in the coupler of the knurling ring.) With the knurling ring pulled back slip the end of the mounting arm onto the mounting stud from which you just removed the plastic. Push the coupler all the way on, and then push forward on the knurling ring that you just pulled back until it springs forward to its original position. It may be necessary to rotate the arm slowly to get the knurling ring to spring forward.

Third: Mount the clamp on the edge of a table or any sturdy surface and tighten it firmly. Bend the arm to the desired position. (To rotate the arm, do not bend it, instead release the knurling ring and rotate it to the appropriate position.) Like any flexible arm the less it is bent, the more rigid it will stay. After bending the arm an excessive number of times, it may need to be replaced. **DO NOT USE THE QUADJOY FOR BENDING THE ARM; GRASP ONLY THE ARM TO BEND THE ARM! USING THE QUADJOY COULD DAMAGE THE QUADJOY OR FLEXIBLE ARM.**

Getting Started:

It is recommended that you adjust your mouse speed to its slowest setting until you are familiarized with the Quadjoy Mouse. This can be done from the Mouse Icon in the Control Panel of PC Based Windows Computers.

First: After you are setup, you will want to practice the button functions, and then scrolling functions. They are identified on you Basic Instructions Page. You will also want to practice movement.

Second: As you become more familiar with the Quadjoy Mouse, feel free to adjust the speed to that which suits you best. For practice we recommend playing games like “solitaire” and “paint brush”.

Third: You will want to clean your Quadjoy Mouse routinely as outlined in the “Cleaning Instructions.”
